Dear Residents of Ward 7,

I hope you are all doing well and continuing to stay safe and healthy through these unprecedented times. I would like to take a moment to sincerely thank you all for your support and confidence in me as your representative for Ward 7.

This past year has presented our community with many challenges due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Nonetheless, our community stayed strong and stayed home. The first and second phases of vaccination have been advancing successfully and we are progressing towards fully overcoming this pandemic.

This year at the council table we achieved a 0% tax levy increase. I was able to secure funding to:

- Continue the Banwell Road Construction
- Upgrade our Parks and Trails
- Improve SandPoint Beach

City council has approved a Traffic Calming Policy that provides the framework to assess, design, and implement calming measures on primarily residential streets. Currently, a Vision Zero Action Plan is being prepared to be presented to council. My primary focus remains increasing the safety, investing in leisure, and infrastructure for our Ward! I will continue to fight for funds in the capital budget to make these things possible.






BUDGET 2021

PARKS!




WARD 7 UPDATES

TRAILS & TREES

- TWO NEW BRIDGES HAVE BEEN ADDED TO TRAILS AT TEEDIE PARK AND MCHUGH. THESE BRIDGES SERVE AS CONNECTIONS FOR GREATER PHYSICAL ACTIVITY AND CONVENIENCE.
- NEW TREES WERE PLANTED ALONG LITTLE RIVER TRAIL AND FLORENCE AVENUE.

ROAD SAFETY & BUS

- A NEW BUS ROUTE WILL BE ADDED FROM FOREST GLADE TO ST.CLAIR HELPING STUDENTS DECREASE COMMUTE TIME STARTING THIS SEPTEMBER.
- A VISION ZERO ACTION PLAN IS CURRENTLY BEING PREPARED WHICH WILL CONSIDER SPEED REDUCTIONS ON RESIDENTIAL STREETS.

BANWELL CONSTRUCTION

- THE FIRST PHASE OF THE MUCH NEEDED BANWELL CONSTRUCTION PROJECT HAS CONCLUDED AND FUNDING FOR THE SECOND PHASE HAS BEEN APPROVED IN THE CAPITAL BUDGET.
- IT IS PROJECTED TO COMMENCE IN THE COMING YEAR. A FOUR LANE ROUNDABOUT WILL BE ADDED AT THE MULBERRY AND BANWELL INTERSECTION.



PARK UPGRADES

- FOREST GLADE PARK WILL BE SEEING
 UPGRADES ACROSS THE BOARD. THIS FALL,
 CONSTRUCTION ON THE NEW APPROVED
 TENNIS COURTS AND THE ADDITION OF
 PICKLE BALL COURTS WILL COMMENCE.
 FUNDING HAS ALSO PERMITTED THE
 ADDITION OF NEW WASHROOMS AND A
 SPLASH PAD. THESE FACILITIES WILL BRING
 NEW LEISURE ACTIVITIES TO OUR WARD!
- AFTER THE COMPLETION OF THE NEARBY APARTMENT CONSTRUCTION, ELIZABETH KISHKON PARK WILL SEE THE ADDITION OF A NEW PARKING LOT. WASHROOMS WILL ALSO BE ADDED IN THE COMING YEAR.
