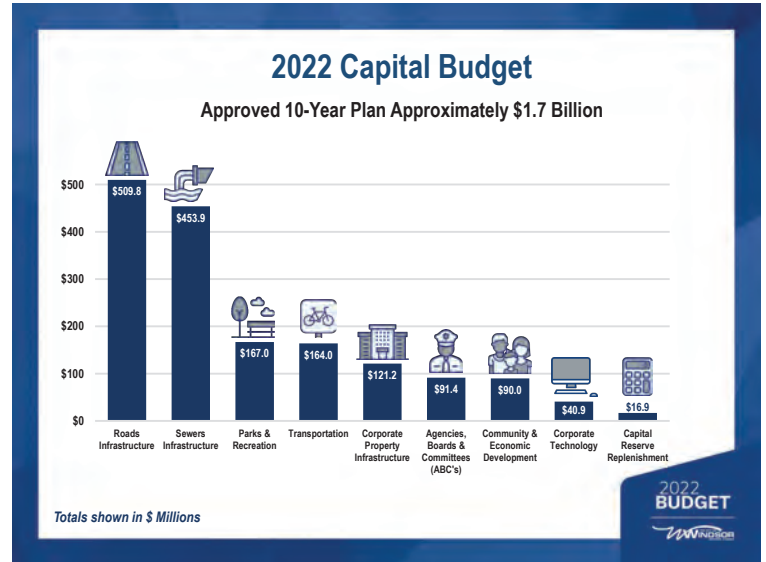
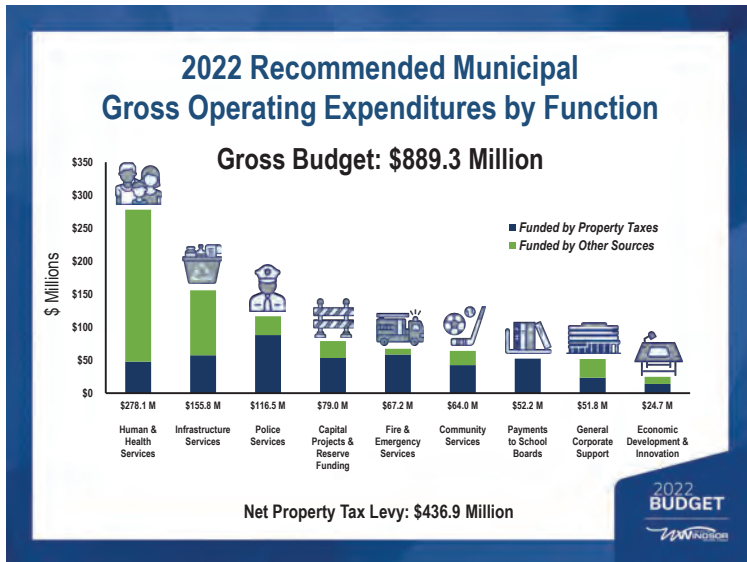

Electricity transmission infrastructure upgrades announced for Windsor and Leamington, which will help support the new Stellantis/LG EV battery plant in Windsor.

Windsor Airport is once again receiving International flights. We are also welcoming Flair Airlines, a low cost carrier, to YQG with new routes.

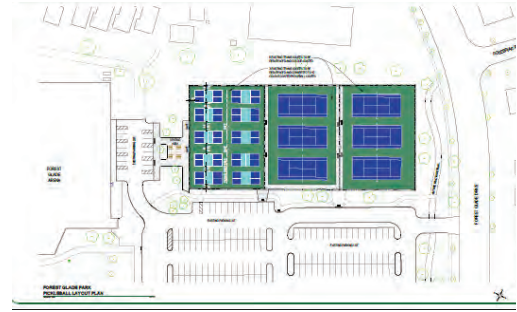

- BLUE HERON PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE REFURBISHMENT
- ADDITION OF 2 PEDESTRIAN BRIDGES, ON TEDDIE PARK AND NEAR MCHUGH, CONNECTING TO THE WFCU



- WORK IS CURRENTLY IN PROGRESS ON THE TENNIS COURTS AT FOREST GLADE PARK



- A NEW WASHROOM HAS BEEN INSTALLED IN FOREST GLADE PARK

- NEW LEFT TURN SIGNAL ON MCNORTON AND BANWELL



## NEW ACUTE CARE HOSPITAL UPDATE

- THE PROVINCE HAS COMMITTED \$9.8 MILLION TO KEEP THE NEW ACUTE CARE HOSPITAL PROJECT MOVING FORWARD. THE PROJECT IS NOW IN PHASE 2 AND WILL INCLUDE COMMUNITY CONSULTATION.

- THE HILL REFERRED TO AS "SUICIDE HILL" HAS BEEN OFFICIALLY RENAMED HOPE HILL

## SANDPOINT BEACH

- ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR THE RELOCATION OF THE BEACH IS SCHEDULED TO BE COMPLETED BY THE END OF 2022
- PECHE ISLAND UPGRADES INCLUDES THE RESTORATION OF THE BRIDGE AND PROTECTION OF THE SHORELINE TO SAVE IT FROM EROSION.
